## Market Comment:

A light yarding of 2598 sheep at Muchea this week with Nutrien selling 1439 of these. 1087 lambs of which 30% were trade quality lambs, predominantly old season sold under reasonable competition over all classes with a highlight of \$170 for a few pens of suckers.

609 ewes yarded, genially good trade and better boning types to top at 150. Rams were small in numbers with continued competition topping at \$140.
