Market Comment:

A total yarding of 5876 at Muchea this week with Nutrien selling 1666 of these. 1082 suckers were sold with heavy lambs \$120-\$131 & lighter new season lambs sold \$80-\$115. Local butchers were very active on fresh dorper lambs weighing 30-35kg live, selling from \$80-\$95. For better types and plain condition \$60-\$80. 2329 old season lambs/hoggets met with limited competition with graziers buying better wether drafts \$80-\$110 (incl skin), plainer types \$60-\$85 and ewe &70-\$105. Heavy mutton sold \$105-\$120 while trade ewes \$80-\$105 and boners \$70-\$85.

Nutrien are 1st sale next week.
