Market Comment:

5950 sheep yarded in Muchea with Nutrien selling 2390 of these. The new season lamb market fluctuated greatly. Heavy lambs above 25kg dressed \$150-\$160 with trade weights \$110-\$140. Fresh young Dorper x Lambs 35kg live sold strongly \$90-\$100. Plain dry store xb lambs saw from \$90-\$95.

Graziers were active on Merino wether & ewe hoggets, with best drafts 55kg live (plus skin length 50mm) topped \$144 with other drafts shorn \$90-\$120. Heavy Mutton over 30kg dressed sold \$110-\$120, with younger mutton selling to graziers \$80-\$100. Trade weight sold \$75-\$110 and poor conditioned ewes from \$40-\$60
