4296 Sheep yarded of which Nutrien had 1785.

699 suckers were yarded with heavy lambs selling \$125-\$152. Lambs 20-22kg dressed sold \$110-\$115, airfreight lambs sold \$80-\$105, stores 30-40kg live \$68-\$92. 1542 mutton where yarded. Bare shorn heavy mutton over 30kg dressed \$110-\$115, 24-30kg mutton \$90-\$105, 18-24kg \$70-\$96. Plain aged ewes \$10-\$40.

Graziers were very active on yellow tag hogget ewes and wethers \$50-\$90.

Rams ride the roller coaster selling \$35-\$80.
