Very few quality lambs yarded with boutique butchers buying heavy lambs \$140-\$152 while trade lambs were \$90-\$115 with both butcher and graziers active.

1000 light store merino lambs were sold to graziers at vales of \$20-\$50 for ewe lambs and wethers \$40-\$75.

1011 mutton had limited competition with heavy ewes \$90-\$120, trade ewes \$70-\$88 with very plain ewes \$20-\$50.

Few heavy wethers sold to butchers topping \$130 while graziers bought stores \$70-\$98.
