## **Market Comment:**

4928 Sheep yarded with 1456 sold by Nutrien.1500 Suckers presented with heavy lambs over 25kg dressed \$140-\$156.

Trade lambs 20-24kg \$100-\$136 with both graziers and local butchers very active. Store lamb graziers paid \$70-\$90 for fresh lambs while plain condition lambs \$35-\$60. 1900 Mutton were sold with heavy ewes limited competition selling \$80-\$100. Trade ewes 20-25kg saw graziers active on younger drafts selling \$65-\$80. Plain and poor condition ewes hard to sell \$30-\$50.

Merino wethers over 50kg live sold to graziers \$95-\$100 store \$50-\$70 and Rams \$20-\$40.

Nutrien are 2nd sale next week.
