Market Comment:

6090 Sheep yarded in Muchea with Nutrien selling 2482 of these.

800 Suckers and 1672 Merino lambs sold with heavy lambs \$150-\$161 trade lambs \$110-\$145 with graziers very active while feedlotters paid \$90-\$105 for better store lambs and lights and plain lambs \$50-\$88.

Heavy Mutton sold \$80-\$100 with limited competition while grazirs and butchers were strong on trade and store ewes \$60-\$90 age dependant.

Merino store wethers sold \$75-\$90 for fwd stores and butchers bought finished wethers \$90-\$110.

Good drafts of Dorper Ram Lambs sold \$90-\$120 while graziers bought white dorper ram hoggets \$60-\$90 and older Merino Rams sold \$20-\$50

Nutrien are 1st sale next week.
