Bigger yarding totalling 9499 which included 2 ewe dispersals.

Nutrien Yarded 3464.

3100 Lambs were presented. The quality was very good for trade and heavy weights. Heavy lambs \$148-\$168 with strong local butcher activity.

Trade lambs were also strong \$120-\$150. Store Lambs \$70-\$100, plain \$40-\$68.

4703 ewes were sold which included 2 dispersals. The graziers chased young ewes up to \$130 while butchers bought heavy ewes \$80-\$105 trade ewes \$75-\$90 and plain aged ewes \$40-\$68.

Store wethers yellow tag \$70-\$90, Plain multiple tagged \$50-\$77 and aged rams \$40-\$60.
