## Market Comment:

Heavy lambs saw spirited competition with sales between \$140-\$155. Trade lambs were also strong with feedlotters and butchers, \$110-\$132. Stores were bought by graziers, \$70-105 for shorn lambs between 30-35kg l/w and plain lambs \$40-\$60. 1524 mutton were sold with graziers active on shedding types.

Heavy ewes sold \$90-\$110 including skin. Trade and good bonning types sold under strong compatition to sell from \$75-\$90. Plain ewes were harder to sell with values \$30-\$60.

Hoggets, 23-26kg dressed, sold \$80-\$95. Plainer sheep were hard to sell, \$45-\$75.
