Lighter yarding this week 4693 sheep yarded and sold.

Nutrien sold 2919.

2184 Lambs were presented for sale. Heavy Lambs over 25kg dressed sold strongly \$140-\$175. Trade Lambs \$100-\$130. Graziers chased store lambs \$80-\$105 while dry poor conditions lambs hard to sell.

Heavy mutton saw limited competition selling \$80-\$95 trade ewes, \$60-\$85 boner ewes. Graziers were active on good lines of younger ewes \$40-\$65 while aged ewes \$20-\$40 and wether ewe hogget \$70-\$90 plainer types \$50-\$65
