Market Comment:

Larger yarding 8068 in total with Nutrien selling 2533. 3663 Lambs were yarded with heavy lambs topping \$170 to ave \$150 while trade lamb sold \$100-\$140 to ave \$125. Shorn store lambs \$70-\$90, wooly lambs \$60-\$80. 2760 mutton sold with heavy ewes 30kg + topped \$95 ave \$80 while trade ewes 20-26kg \$65-\$85. Boner Ewes \$40-\$55 while aged plain sheep \$30-\$45. Very few wethers yarded but those that were, were heavy 60kg live + \$70-\$95. Nutrien are 2nd sale next week.
