7022 sheep yarded with Nutrien accounting for 2281 of these.

2769 lambs were sold with heavy weights selling \$130-\$145. Trade lambs held their values with local butchers active \$90-\$110. Graziers were strong buying light weight lambs \$30-\$60.

2717 mutton were sold with heavy ewes over 25kg+ selling from \$70-\$85. Graziers very active on heavy young ewes \$70-\$78. Trade ewes sold \$50-\$70 and poor ewes \$20-\$40.

Wether & ewe hoggets over 25kg dressed \$70-\$90. please drafts \$30-\$60.
