

MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 3rd April

Today agents yarded a total of 85 veal with Nutrien livestock selling 82 of them.

Numbers and demand jumped this week with quality again being mixed but extra competition from graziers and butchers helped push the price up to \$50/h.

Light weight slaughter calves sold from \$600 to \$750 for a Droughtmaster heifer calf. Backgrounding Angus steers also bounced back in value to reach up to \$800.
