Market Comment:

5838 sheep yarded with Nutrien yarding 1850.

Heavy lambs sold strongly \$120-\$140 while competition on trade and store lambs was limited. Trade lambs \$90-\$118, stores \$60-\$90 and plain light lambs \$20-\$55. Heavy ewes had limited competition selling \$65-\$75. Trade ewes 20-25kg selling from \$50-\$65 with light ewes \$10-\$40. Dorper ewes suitable for breeding \$80-\$130. Merino wethers purchased by butchers \$65-\$90 while graziers paid \$20-\$68 for yellow tag pain condition wethers.
