## MUCHEA CATTLE REPORT 17 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ April 2023

Nutrien Livestock sold 397 Cattle of the 452 offered at Muchea Monday 17th April. Numbers fell sharply after no sale last week, however, the quality of the local trade and yearlings was very good. Only 12 heavy bulls were available and values eased $15 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ to top at $272 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Heavy trade steers $550-600 \mathrm{~kg}$ sold to 320c/kg while grain assisted Angus steers $450-500 \mathrm{~kg}$ sold to $380 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Heavy trade heifers $650 \mathrm{~kg}+$ sold to $294 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ with lines $500 \mathrm{~kg}+$ sold to $332 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Grain assisted angus heifers 400 kg sold to $360 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Angus yearling steers under 200 kg realised $434 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ with over 300 kg to $404 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. Local yearling heifers were few in number and ranged from 270-320c/kg. Pastoral heifers were unchanged at $180-280 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. A small but good quality penning of cows saw values full equal.
