Light yarding today of 3293, Nutrien yarded 993 of these.
 Heavy lambs were strong early pushed by independant butchers.
 Selling \$125-\$135 for lambs 28kg+.
 Trade lambs held recent values \$90-\$115 limited grazier activity saw lambs 33-40kg sell from \$45-\$70.
 Mutton Values were equal with heavy ewes in limited supply selling \$80-\$90 while stronger competition on trade weights \$70-\$85.
 Boners were firm at \$40-\$60.
 Ram Lambs 20-25kg dressed \$60-\$90 plainer typed \$20-\$30, aged rams \$30-\$40.
