	Light yarding today of 3293, Nutrien yarded 993 of these. Heavy lambs were strong early pushed by independant butchers. Selling \$125-\$135 for lambs 28kg+. Trade lambs held recent values \$90-\$115 limited grazier activity saw lambs 33-40kg sell from\$45-\$70. Mutton Values were equal with heavy ewes in limited suppy selling \$80-\$90 while stronger competition on trade weights \$70-\$85. Boners were firm at \$40-\$60.
