Market Comment:

7550 sheep yarded and sold in Muchea with Nutrien selling 4373 of these. 356 new season suckers yarded of which most there dorpers, these sold from \$50-\$90 while merinos \$30-\$40. Heavy lambs over 25kg were 10% of the yarding with values \$100-\$110. Trade lambs 20-24kg were 30% of the yarding selling \$60-\$90 and 60% of the yarding were store condition, limited interest with prices \$10-\$45. 1804 mutton were yarded. Heavy ewes \$70-\$90, trade ewes selling \$50-\$80, boners \$40-\$60 and plain ewes \$5-\$15.

Merino wethers over 60kg selling \$100-\$110 and 45-58kg wethers welling \$65-\$90. Todays rams made \$30-\$50.
