Market Comment:

2264 sheep yarded at Muchea today with Nutrien accounting for 614. 323 lambs were yarded with heavy weight lambs topping out at \$138, these were lambs dressing at approximately 33kg. Most sales of trade lambs were between \$70-\$118. Limited mutton yarding of 420 saw a top of \$100 for 26kg, dressed ewes with 50mm of skin, most mutton sales ranging from \$60-\$87 at rates of \$3 p/kg dressed. Limited wethers presented with heavy weights realising a top of \$110, heavy rams ranged between \$20-\$35.
