Market Comment:

A light yarding of 3030 sheep of which Nutrien sold 1128.
 Heavy lambs were stronger by up to \$25 selling at rates of \$5.50-\$6/kg topping at \$148. Trade lambs \$100-\$118, rates \$5-\$5.30/kg. 38-44kg live lambs selling \$70-\$90. Heavy ewe mutton topping \$115 at rates of \$3-\$3.30/kg dressed. Trade ewes selling \$2.70-\$310/kg. Boner ewes \$30-\$60.
 Wether mutton sold to a top of \$126 at rates \$3.50/kg including \$10 skin with most sales \$70-\$105, rates of \$2.95-\$3.30/kg.
 Store hoggets sold \$50-\$70 while ages rams \$25-\$35.

Nutrien will be 1st sellers next week.
