Market Comment:

Muchea had a total offering of 6899 with Nutrien yarding 2297 lambs and 561 sheep. The lamb yarding was predominately merino store types. Better trade type lambs realised up to \$120 but were down \$15 against last week. The store merino lambs saw wethers \$25-\$53 and ewe lambs \$10-\$75, back \$10-\$15.

Mutton very limited supply with limited enquiry values eased \$5.

Rams were firm.

A reminder to start mouthing lambs and declare on National Vendor Declaration. Also, there are lines of poorly drained stock being presented which are being discounted.

Nutrien will be 2nd sellers next week.
