Market Comment:

Agents today yarded a total of 5202 with Nutrien selling 1880 of these. 36% of the yarding today being lambs. Heavy lambs 25kg+ sold from \$4-\$4.20/kg. Trade lambs 20-25kg sold from \$4.50-\$5.50/kg depending on the finish of the lambs, selling \$90-\$130. Feeder lambs 35-40kg live, \$35-\$60.

Heavy mutton selling \$2.50-\$2.80 per kilo while trade ewes \$2.60-\$3/kg, \$70-\$90.

Boner mutton selling \$35-\$50.

Heavy merino wethers selling from \$80-\$100 while plainer types \$50-\$70.

Aged rams selling \$20-\$40. Ram lambs \$50-\$90 and dorper ram lambs \$75-\$100.

Nutrien will be 3rd sellers next week.
