Market Comment:

Agents today yarded a total of 9373 head with 70% of yarding being merino lambs and 5% crossbred lambs. Heavy lambs sold from \$4-\$4.70/kg dressed topping at \$119 to average \$105. Trade lambs 18-24kg selling \$75-\$95. Better store types 40-45kg live sold \$50-\$70 while plainer types selling \$20-\$45.

Heavy mutton sold \$2.50-\$2.80/kg selling \$70-\$90. Trade ewes \$48-\$70 while boner ewes \$20-\$45.

Heavy wethers 70kg+ topped out \$112 while 50-65kg wethers \$70-\$100.

Mature rams \$20-\$50.

Nutrien will be 2nd sellers next week.
