7616 Sheep sold in Muchea with Nutrien selling 3289 of these.
 Yarding had 187 new season suckers selling a top of \$90 at rates \$4.50-\$5/kg.
 Old season trade lambs sold \$50-\$70 at rates \$3-\$3.50/kg.
 Plain drafts of merino lambs \$25-\$45 very limited enquiry.
 Mutton Values were easier across the board with heavy ewes over 30kg dressed topping \$75 to over \$58 at rates \$2-\$2.20/kg.
 Trade ewes 20-28kg dressed had very limited interest selling from \$26-\$38.
 Plain mutton sold \$10-\$25.
 Aged rams sold \$20-\$60 while heavy red tag rams \$30-\$45, lightweights \$10-\$25
