 being ewes, 141 old season & 53 suckers. No heavy trade lambs were yarded today. Trade suckers, 22kg, made \$90-\$100 estimated at \$4.50/kg. Lighter lambs, 18-20kg dressed, made \$40-\$65, feeders \$20-\$45 and stores \$10-\$25. Mutton was back slightly. 25kg dressed ewes topped \$45 estimated at \$1.80/kg. Trade mutton made \$25-\$35 and boners \$15-\$20. Export rams topped at \$35 per head with medium rams selling \$15-\$20.
