Market Comment:

Muchea yarded 5382 sheep with 2145 being old season lambs and 602 suckers. Nutrien yarded 2057 sheep with 558 old seasons and 285 new season suckers. Trade suckers sold from \$70-\$82 at rates of \$3.50-\$4/kg dressed. Store new seasons \$40-\$55. Trade old seasons \$50-\$60 while old seasons store lambs \$35-\$45. Heavy mutton sold \$42-\$50 while trade weight ewes \$30-\$40 and boners \$10-\$20. Store condition red tag ewe hoggets selling \$30-\$40 and wethers \$30-\$52. Heavy aged rams today sold \$20-\$40. Plainer type rams selling \$10-\$25.

Next week Nutrien will be 3rd sellers.
