Market Comment:

5699 Sheep yarded in Muchea on the 26th September with Nutrien selling 2042 of these. A very mixed yarding of lambs with the majority being of store dry condition. 40kg liveweight new seasons sold \$40-\$57, lightweight stores \$25-\$38.

Old season lambs over 48kg live sold \$60-\$67. Store old seasons \$45-\$58 while very plain old seasons \$15-\$25.

Heavy mutton 25kg+ dressed \$30-\$46 while trade weight ewe mutton sold \$25-\$32. Boners sold \$15-\$26.

Ewe hoggets 24kg+ dressed selling from \$45-\$60 while plainer types \$15-\$30. Store Wether hoggets \$18-\$30.

Nutrien are 2nd sale next week.
