## Market Comment:

Today's Muchea agents yarded 6633, up 934 from last week's sale.  
 Nutrien yarded 2905 of these, majority made up of ewes.  
 Heavy crossbred lambs 24kg+ sold between \$100-\$135 up to \$5.20/kg.  
 Trade lambs sold \$65-\$95, light trade \$38-\$60.  
 Minimal change in the wether market, export types selling from \$32-\$48 per head, lighter types \$18-\$30.  
 Heavy mutton topped at \$45, most drafts of trade mutton selling from \$22-\$35 at \$1.30/kg.  
 Boners selling from \$5-\$20.  
 Export rams sold \$25-\$39 and lighter rams \$5-\$20.
