## **Market Comment:**

Todays Muchea agents yarded 7868, with Nutrien selling 2973 of these.

Heavy lambs were in short supply, selling from \$100-\$133 at rates of \$4.20-\$4.75/kg. Trade lambs sold steadily \$60-\$74, store lambs saw competition ease as the sale went on selling from \$30-\$40. Heavy ewe mutton sold from \$40-\$50 (Inc Skin) returning rates of \$1.50-\$1.70/kg.

Trade ewes sold from \$20-\$30 while boning and plain ewes sold from \$5-\$18. Red tag wethers sold from \$20-\$35 while red tag ewes sold from \$10-\$28. Rams sold \$10-\$35.

Nutrien are 4th sale next week.
