## Market Comment:

Muchea yarded 5676 sheep this week, down 2192 from last weeks sale. Nutrien yarded 1589 of these, back from 2973. Today saw a limited supply of heavy suckers. Trade suckers 20-23kg selling \$65-\$100 at rates of \$3.80-\$4.20/kg. Light trade lambs sold from \$35-\$50 while feeders \$24-\$40.

Heavy mutton was back \$5-\$10 today, the best of the ewes selling from \$34-\$45 at rates up to \$1.80/kg. Lighter trade mutton sold \$20-\$40 while boner \$15-\$20. Merino hoggets gained slightly today selling from \$30-\$45.

Export rams today selling from \$15-\$50.

Next week Nutrien will be 3rd sellers.
