## **Market Comment:**

Muchea agents yarded 10,336 sheep with Nutrien yarding 5397 of these.

Heavy lambs over 25kg dressed topped \$132 returning values of up to \$5.50/kg. Most heavy lambs averaged \$120 at rates of \$4.80/kg. Trade lambs sold to stronger grazier interest at \$50-83. Plain and poor lambs \$10-\$48.

Heavy mutton sold \$25-\$35, trade ewes \$15-\$23 and plain condition ewes sold from \$5-\$14.

Heavy wether hoggets sold up to \$50 while light and medium weight \$10-\$30. Merino ewe hoggets sold consistantly \$10-\$38.
