Market Comment:

Muchea agents yarded 11,837 sheep and lambs with Nutrien yarding 5547 of these. Heavy lambs topping \$142, averaging \$125, returning rates of \$5.20/kg in the pen. Trade lambs sold strongly \$98-\$118. Store lambs \$50-\$80 to feeders while light and plain condition lambs sold from \$10-\$40 with limited competition.

Ewe mutton was harder to sell on a few drafts. Heavy ewes sold from \$35-\$40 with most sales of mutton \$15-\$22, plain and poor mutton \$2-\$10.

Hoggets sold to the trade \$25-\$40 while plainer types \$5-\$20

Ram lambs suitable for slaughter \$20-\$30 while crossbred ram lambs \$50-\$60. Poor condition and aged \$2-\$10.
