## **Market Comment:**

Muchea agents yarded 5990 sheep and lambs with Nutrien yarding 19074 of these including 705 lambs. The overall yarding was of mixed quality with the majority of the lambs being of heavier and trade weight types. Heavy lambs sold from \$110-\$120, trade lambs sold \$80-\$100 at rates of \$1.60-\$2/kg live.

Store lambs sold to graziers \$60-\$80 while plain lambs \$20-\$40.

Mutton values remained equal. Heavy ewes \$30-\$40, trade ewe \$20-\$30. Boner ewes were harder to sell \$8-\$15 while plain ewes \$2-\$6. Hoggets suitable for killing sold from \$20-\$45 while store types \$3-\$15.

The next sale will be held on January 9th 2024 where Nutrien will be 2nd sellers.
