Market Comment:

A total yarding of 9,058 sheep yarded at Muchea today with Nutrien accounting for 3,195 of these.

The top of the lambs today sold between \$105-\$138 at rates up to \$5.40c/kg. Trade lambs sold from \$85-\$110, light trade \$68-\$90, feeder lambs \$30-\$5 and store lambs \$10-\$28.

The top of the mutton today sold \$35-\$40 up to rates of \$1.50/head in the pen.

Trade ewes sold \$20-\$30, boners \$12-\$22 with light boning types \$5-\$10.

Wethers suitable for slaughter sold from \$30-\$55 and rams making \$20-\$34.

Next week Nutrien will be 1st sellers.
