## MUCHEA CATTLE REPORT 15 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ January 2024

Nutrien Livestock sold 616 cattle out of a total 1130 at Muchea Monday 15th January. Cows and bulls across all categories dominated the yarding with the balance mainly light and plain yearling/weaner steers \& heifers showing the effects of the season. Heavy local bulls were firm to $20 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ higher. Young bulls suitable for live export and feed were easier due to lack of competition. A small but good quality run of heavy steers saw values improve 20c/kg and heavy heifers also gaining $10-20 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. An excellent penning of heavy local cows saw best quality lines gain $6 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ to sell to $172 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$, this flowed onto the medium weights that topped at $160 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$ and lightweights to $144 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$.
