Market Comment:

A total yarding of 7,805 with Nutrien accounting for 4,065 of these.

A larger yarding of lambs today sold to strong competition. The top of the lambs realised \$150 selling up to \$6/kg. Trade lambs ranged from \$90-\$115, light trades \$70-\$90 while feeder lambs with increased demand sold from \$35-\$60 and store \$28-\$35.

Heavy mutton today topped at \$47 for ewes with skin. Trade mutton realised \$20-\$30 and boners \$10-\$20.

Wethers suitable for slaughter sold \$30-\$63 with stores \$20-\$32.

Heavy rams sold from \$25-\$45, lighter types \$10-\$17.

Next week Nutrien will be 4th sellers.
