Market Comment:

A total yarding of 12,013 at Muchea today with Nutrien yarding 4010 of these. Quality was back a bit today across the yarding. The best of the lambs today selling from \$113-\$130 returning rates up to \$5.80/kg. Most of the trade lambs today sold \$90-\$115, light trade \$65-\$90 and feeders \$35-\$50.

Heavy mutton with skin sold up to \$45 with the majority of the trade mutton selling from \$20-\$35, the boner ewes selling from \$8-\$20

Hoggets selling to the trade sold from \$30-\$50, lighter hoggets hard to sell at \$20-\$30. Rams suitable for slaughter sold \$25-\$42 while lighter types \$2-\$15.

Next week Nutrien will be 3rd sellers.
