## Market Comment:

A total yarding of 10,027 with Nutrien yarding 7,640 of these. A stronger yarding this week saw the best of the lambs selling from \$125-\$140 at rates up to \$5.80/kg. Trade lambs returning \$100-\$127 while feeding \$40-\$98 and stores \$20-\$40.

Heavy mutton sold to increased demand selling from \$32-\$50, trade mutton \$20-\$35 and boners \$1-\$20.

Trade wethers sold \$35-\$50, store \$20-\$30.

Medium rams sold \$18-\$32 and export rams \$30-\$48.

Next week Nutrien will be 2nd sellers.
