Market Comment:

A total yarding of 8,823 sheep and lambs at Muchea, Tuesday 13th February, with Nutrien accounting for 5,107 of these.

- 3,661 lambs were yarded of which 374 were heavy lambs selling from \$130-\$152.
- 1,800 trade lambs sold from \$90-\$115. Balance of the lamb yarding were in store condition selling from \$20-\$89.
- 2,625 mutton sold with heavy weights \$30-\$52, trade weight \$20-\$30 and boners \$8-\$16 while poor mutton and hoggets were extremely hard to sell \$1-\$5.

Ewe and wether hoggets over 25kg dressed \$35-\$55. Plainer drafts sold for \$1-\$12.
