Market Comment:

Muchea agents yarded 6420 sheep & lambs with Nutrien accounting for 1962 of these. Heavy lambs were in short supply selling \$110-\$134.

Trade lambs \$80-\$110, airfreight lambs \$60-\$80 while plain and poor lambs sold from \$10-\$20.

Heavy mutton was under stronger competition selling \$40-\$47. Trade mutton sold strongly \$30-\$42 while boners sold \$18-\$28, poor ewes were hard to sell \$5-\$12. Hogget market was a tale of 3 stories, plain and light sheep chased by eastern states and local butchers \$15-\$30. Trade hoggets sold to local trade \$28-\$39 while heavy merino hoggets sold \$40-\$60. A few drafts of breeding dorper hoggets sold \$90-\$120. Heavy Rams \$20-\$35
