Market Comment:

Agents yarded 12,887 sheep & lambs with Nutrien accounting for 3907 of these. Today's yarding consisted of mostly store lambs and mutton. Heavy lambs sold to stronger competition at \$100-\$120 with very odd small drafts selling to \$125. Trade lambs \$70-\$95, store lambs \$40-\$65 while plainer drafts \$10-\$35. Heavy ewes selling \$30-\$40, trade ewes \$20-\$31 and good boning ewes \$5-\$15. Plain and poor condition sheep very hard to sell \$1-\$5. Heavy ewe hoggets sold \$40-\$50, while trade weight \$20-\$35 again poor condition sheep hard to sell \$1-\$10
