Market Comment:

Agents yarded and sold 9,469 sheep and lambs with Nutrien yarding 3,874 of these. Heavy lambs were equal from last weeks sale, selling from \$100 to \$125. Trade lambs sold from \$85 to \$105 with feedlotter competing on heavier drafts. Airfrieght lambs selling from \$60 to \$85 while plain drafts sold from \$30 to \$62. Poor lambs sold from \$10 to \$20. Heavy mutton sold from \$35 to \$45 and Trade mutton from \$28 to \$33. Boners sold from \$15 to \$27. Plain and poor condition ewes sold from \$3 to \$13. Trade weight hoggets sold from \$35 to \$65. Plain condition drafts sold from \$15 to \$28, while poor condition hoggets are difficult to sell, they went from \$3 to \$10.
