Market Comment:				
Agents yarded 9,497 sheep & lambs with Nutrien yarding 3,266. Heavy lambs over 25kg dressed topped at \$120 to average \$110. Trade lambs sold from \$70 to \$90 while feeder lambs sold to good support \$60 to \$80. Plainer drafts sold at \$40 to \$56 while poor and immature lambs sold from \$3 to \$35. Ewe mutton sold strongly for heavy ewes topping out at \$48 while trade ewes sold for \$30 to \$40. Boners sold from \$18 to \$26 and poor condition ewes \$5 to \$16. Hoggets suitable for slaughter sold from \$35 to \$49 while stores sold from \$5 to \$28. Heavy rams are not wanted and sold at \$1. Plain rams sold at \$5 to \$10.
