Market Comment:

Agents yarded 10,340 sheep with Nutrien yarding 4,880. Heavy lambs held values selling from \$100 to \$130 returning rate being from \$4.80 to \$5.12/kg dressed. Trade lambs sold from \$80 to \$98, while store sheep sold strongly from \$40 to \$65. Plain lambs sold from \$10 to \$28. Ewe mutton, including 50mm skin types, where fully equal from last week selling from \$30 to \$46. Trade weight mutton sold from \$20 to \$30 while boners sold from \$5 to \$18. Hogget market held firm with most of the sales ranging from \$18 to \$40. Heavy hoggets sold from \$42 to \$60. Rams were selling from \$10 to \$30.

Next week Nutrien will be fourth sellers.
