



## **Muceha Sheep Report 26/11/2024**

*Yarding 5133 / sheep 3588 / lambs 1545*

Supplies continue to trend downwards with just over 1000 less than last week's total. The majority of lambs on offer were trade and heavy weights showing an improvement in quality while Store and light lambs were in short supply with only smaller cleanup lots yarded. The buyer gallery was fairly crowded with most of the regulars in attendance along with several restockers and many interested onlookers.

Recent gains in lamb values held firm today with store lambs selling from \$40 to \$100 while light lambs returned \$80 to \$131/head. Trade lambs sold from \$110 to \$165 and heavy lambs from \$157 to \$196/head.

Hoggets also remained equal as Merino wether hoggets carrying weight made \$55 to \$98 while Merino ewe hoggets returned \$67 to \$90/head. Crossbred hoggets showing condition ranged from \$78 to \$99 and young rams sold to a top of \$83/head.

Mutton eased \$5/7 across the board with very plain ewes selling from \$3 to \$20 while boning grades ranged from \$25 to \$50/head. Medium ewes were selling up to \$70 and heavy ewes reached \$96/head. Heavy wethers sold to a top of \$98 and mature rams returned \$5 to \$68/head.
