



Muceha Sheep Report 14/01/2025

*Yarding 14330 / sheep 8859 / lambs 5471*

Muceha had an increase of almost 5000 sheep and lambs today and quality was abundant in both lamb and mutton sectors. The extra volume had no negative effect on the market as most categories either increased or remained equal with only store lambs dropping slightly after last week's higher gains.

Store lambs eased marginally by \$2/3 selling from \$46 to \$110 while light lambs lifted another \$4/5 making \$94 to \$147/head. Trade lambs gained \$5/7 selling from \$120 to \$187 and heavy lambs followed suite gaining \$10/12 to realize \$229/head.

Merino wether hoggets were starting at \$50 up to \$122 with weight and a fleece while Merino ewe hoggets ranged from \$75 to \$115 again with a fleece. Crossbred hoggets with weight and finish sold from and \$70 to \$120 and young rams sold to a top of \$108/head.

Very plain ewes sold from \$36 to \$50 while heavier framed stores lifted \$5 making \$64 to \$85/head. Medium ewes also gained slightly to return \$80 to \$115 while heavy ewes sold up to \$120 with a jacket. Heavy wethers peaked at \$110 while mature rams ranged from \$20 to \$100/head.
