

Muchea Sheep Report 28/01/2025

Yarding 9166 / sheep 4111 / lambs 5055

Numbers were back after the long weekend however lambs were still in good supply. Trade and heavy lambs eased in \$15/20 while lighter lambs held their ground to stay firm. Mutton prices were equal with a full buyer's gallery including several agents buying the bigger lines for restocking clients.

Store lambs ranged from \$46 to \$73 and with bigger frames up to \$120 while light lambs were selling from \$100 to 138/head. Trade lambs eased making \$110 to \$160 while heavy lambs returned \$132 to \$190/head.

Merino wether hoggets ranged from \$65 to \$99 while the better Merino ewe hoggets \$70 to \$125 with a jacket mostly to restockers. Cross-bred hoggets with weight sold from \$68 to \$124 while young rams topped out at \$126/head

Boner ewes were selling from \$31 to \$74 while medium ewes returned \$55 to \$90 and heavy ewes sold up to \$115 with a fleece. Heavy wethers made \$80 to \$140 while mature Rams sold from \$30 to \$110/head.
