



Muchea Cattle Report 04/03/2025

*721 liveweight and 0 veal / total 721*

There was a low volume of cattle yarded today which is usually the case after a long weekend at this time of year. The market overall lifted 5/10c over a reasonably even spread of categories with both quality and demand a contributing factor.

Weaner steers were selling from 220c to 300c while weaner heifers ranged from 100c to 268c/head. A good lineup of well-presented Yearling steers sold from 240c to 320c while yearling heifers returned 220c to 274c/kg.

The limited pens of grown steers were making 244c to 268c while grown heifers sold from 230c to 268c/head. Store cows started from 50c up to 170c while medium cows returned 172c to 216c and most prime cows sold from 190c to 244c with a pen of exceptional cows realizing 250c/kg.

Shipping bulls sold from 160c to 270c and slaughter bulls returned 190c to 250c/kg.
