

Muchea Sheep Report 03/06/2025

Yarding 7,597/ sheep 2886/ lambs 4711

Numbers halved this week mostly due to rain and the long weekend however this did nothing to dampen values. A full buying gallery ensured top prices with most lamb categories lifting while sheep values remain firm to slightly dearer.

Store lambs gained \$4/5 and were selling from \$45 to \$130 while light lambs made \$110 to \$150/head. Trade lambs lifted \$6/8 and sold from \$123 to \$180 while heavy lambs returned \$150 to a top of \$241, gaining \$10/12/head.

Merino wether hoggets ranged from \$100 to \$166 while Prime Merino ewe hoggets also topped at \$166/head. Heavy Crossbred hoggets sold from \$90 to \$182 and younger rams sold to a top of \$200/head.

Boner mutton was selling from \$80 to \$140 while medium ewes returned \$130 to \$160 and heavy ewes sold to a top of \$177/head. Heavy wethers made \$110 to \$190 while mature rams ranged from \$30 to \$136/head.
