

Muchea Cattle Report 05/08/2025

537 liveweight and 11 veal / total 548

Numbers were down for a small yarding of 548 head at Muchea. A mixed quality yarding dominated by lightweight pastoral yearlings and weaners. Trade weight steers and heifers sold to 330c and local bred yearling steers topped at 400c/kg. Heavy weight cows gained 5c selling to 310c while heavy bulls in demand topping at 340c/kg.

Weaner steers sold from 328c to 400c while pastoral weaner heifers made 50c to 236c quality dependent.

Local yearling steers sold from 260c to 400c while heifers returned 200c to 350c and pastoral types made 80c to 230c/kg.

Grown steers weighing over 600kg made 318c while lighter weights sold for 278c to 330c/kg. Grown heifers weighing under 540kg made 330c and weights over 540kg sold for 320c /kg.

Heavy weight cows were in demand selling from 270c to 310c while store cows gained at 50c to 268c/kg. Heavy bulls gained selling from 270c to 340c and medium weights made 270c to 290c while light weights returned 180c to 320c/kg.
